

New Orleans Airport to Baton Rouge

Follow signs at N.O. Airport to Interstate 10
Take I-10 West to Baton Rouge
After about 50 minutes of “swampway” you will approach Baton Rouge.
Don't speed! It is expensive.
In daytime, you will eventually see and cross a lake.
Take the Dalrymple Drive exit just after the lake.
This exit loops around and leads you to a stopsign.
Go right (so you will pass underneath the freeway); this is Dalrymple drive,
Follow this past the lake, past some fraternity houses, until you arrive at the
intersection of Dalrymple and Highland Road.
You can see the LSU Information Center here.

- If coming to Choppin Hall, go across Highland Road and turn right into the Info. Center Parking lot to get detailed information, parking pass, etc.
- If going to Pleasant Hall, go across Highland Road and continue about 100 yards until you see the Continuing Education/Pleasant Hall parking lot. Turn right into the lot.
- If you are going to faculty club, turn LEFT onto Highland Road
Drive past big field (on right) and Law Center (on left)
Faculty club is on your left at end of big field.

Baton Rouge to New Orleans Airport

There is no East-bound entrance to I-10 at Dalrymple (incredible, isn't it?)
So, you must leave from the South End of LSU along South Stadium Drive until you hit Stanford Drive. Take Stanford to the I-10 entrance. Airport is clearly marked when you get to N.O.
